TIPS Training

TIPS (Training for Intervention ProcedureS) is a dynamic, skills-based training program designed to prevent intoxication, drunk driving and underage drinking by enhancing the fundamental "people skills" of servers, sellers and consumers of alcohol. TIPS gives individuals the knowledge and confidence they need to recognize potential alcohol-related problems and intervene to prevent alcohol-related tragedies.

In order to help protect local merchants from inadvertent sales of alcohol to minors and our community from negative effects of underage drinking, the Alliance for Better Communities will provide area licensees and their employees with a comprehensive NYS Liquor Authority-approved TIPS training for merchants to help them fully comply with the laws for alcohol sales. The goal is to provide current, accurate information necessary to help avoid underage sales.
